1. Town of Eden Regular March Board Meeting was called to order at 6:39 p.m. by Chairman Rick Zemlicka. Jacob moved to certify the open meetings law. Seconded by Dennis. Motion carried.
2. Jacob motioned to approve the agenda. Seconded by Dennis. Motion carried.
3. Jacob motioned to approve the minutes from Feb. 2, 2026. Seconded by Dennis. Motion carried.
4. Public comments
 - a) Valerie Foley presented her resume to apply for the garbage/recycling attendant
5. Unfinished Business
 - a) April 25th Shredding Event was discussed. No volunteers yet except for current board, still looking
6. New Business
 - a) Steve Linscheid presented the call history for 2021 thru 2025 for the Cobb-Eden Fire District
 - b) Jacob motioned to award Oakdale Gravel/Grading bid to Lepke Trucking and Excavating LLC. In addition, awarding the remaining Gravel/Grading bids to J&N Stone LLC/Rural Excavating. Dennis seconded the motion. Motion carried.
 - c) Jacob motioned to award the Electrical work to A.B. Electric LLC. Seconded by Dennis and motion carried.
 - d) Dennis motioned to set the Road Inspection meeting date for Friday, March 20, 2026, at 8am. Jacob seconded the motion and the motion carried.
 - e) Roun Tree Trimming was discussed. Further discussion will take place at the August or September meeting
 - f) Brian will post the spring weight limits to all town roads.
 - g) Woods Batwing Mower was discussed to replace or downsize existing mower. Existing 2017 mower needs to be taken for maintenance. Jacob motioned to get a quote for a 10 ft cut and a 13-1/2 ft cut option and trade-in amount for existing mower. Dennis seconded the motion and the motion carried.
 - h) Status of Badger Hollow Road. Jacob moved and Dennis seconded to table to April's meeting.
 - i) Jacob motioned to change to date for the Annual meeting from April 15 to April 22, following the State Statues. Dennis seconded the motion and the motion carried.
7. Sarena gave the treasurer report and monthly bills payment report. Jacob motioned and Dennis seconded to accept treasurer report and monthly bills report. Motion carried.
8. Patrolman report – Started work on Willow Spring, debris has been pushed-up as much as possible. Rick asked about a beam in the salt shed. Jacob motioned to accept the Patrolman report and Dennis seconded. Motion carried.

Rick requested instead of cash reimbursement for (2) keyless door knobs, he would exchange for the four vehicle chains in the cold shed. Dennis motion to approve exchange and Jacob seconded and motion carried. Jacob motioned and Dennis seconded to approve Chairman's report. Motion carried.
