

June 1, 2026

1. Town of Eden Regular Board Meeting called to order at 6:32 p.m. by Chairman Rick Zemlicka. Jacob Hamilton moved to certify the open meetings law. Seconded by Dennis Pierick. Motion carried.
2. Jacob motioned to amend the agenda by removing item #6 (f), a repeated listing of the Certificate of Deposits. Seconded by Dennis. Motion carried. Jacob motioned to approve the remaining agenda after amended. Seconded by Dennis. Motion carried.
3. Jacob motioned to amend the 05/04/26 meeting minutes. Spelling error in #6 (c), 4th sentence, proposed to replace purposed. Seconded by Dennis, and motion carried. Jacob motioned to approve the remaining minutes after amended. Dennis seconded and motion carried. Rick requested a copy of statement from May, 2026 meeting, item #7 (j) from Jacob Hamilton.

5. Unfinished Business - None
6. New Business
 - a) Roads
 - Jacob motioned that contract with Scott Construction for Double Chip Sealing of Wolenec Road to continue at current 16'-0" without the Local Road Improvement Program (LRIP). Rick seconded the motion and the motion carried.
 - Discuss about Tower Road, around the quarry, washed during the April's flooding storm. Jacob motion that Brian fill with 3/4" gravel. Additionally, to contact a contractor to advise work for next year. Dennis seconded with adding to the motion to flag/cone area by tomorrow and the gravel to be completed within 14 days. Motion carried.
 - Dennis motioned to add a 15-mph sign to be added with existing curve sign on south bound, Tower Road. Jacob seconded the motion and the motion carried.
 - Dennis discussed the lack of signs to mark culvert at the bottom of hill on Tower Road. Dennis motioned to add double sided marker and to order if needed. Jacob seconded and the motion carried.
 - Dennis motioned to add two intersection signs on Tower Road on both sides of Wolenec Road intersection. Seconded by Jacob. Motion carried.
 - Dennis motioned to install the double arrow sign as previously approved on Willow Springs Road where Bridge Road intersects it. Jacob seconded the motion and the motion carried.
 - b) Jacob motioned to **NOT** renew at maturity and withdrawal the fund in the Certificate of Deposits numbers, 180031091, 180031103 and 180031115 after the date of maturity and deposit into the Town of Eden checking account number ending in 0062. Dennis seconded the motion and the motion carried. Money will be used to pay for equipping the plow truck and road work.
 - c) Rick motioned to hire Reynolds Lumber to repair both roof valleys. Seconded by Jacob. Motion carried. Rick will contact Reynolds Lumber to schedule the work.
 - d) Dennis motioned to purchase 6 reflective safety vests. Seconded by Jacob. Motion carried. Brian will order.

- e) Cheryl presented the Liquor License applications for 2026. Tower Junction applied to renew its Class "B" Beer and Regular "Class B" Liquor License with 4 Operator's License. Baskets & Beyond LLC applied to renew its Class "A" Beer and "Class A" Liquor. Blackhawk Outdoors did not apply to renew its license. Jacob motioned to approve Liquor Licenses and fee structure. Dennis seconded the motion and the motion carried.
7. Treasurer's report, Sarena Heins wasn't present but provided the report and monthly bills for review. Jacob motioned to accept the report and monthly bills as is. Dennis seconded the motion and the motion carried.
8. Brian reported that he is almost done with the first round of mowing. The single action lift cylinder on the plow truck doesn't come down. Brian wants to get an estimate from Tri-State for new cylinder. The Oshkosh block heater installation appointment has not been made yet. Batwing mower needs some adjustment which will require bigger wrenches. The mower leaves a strip in the center. Jacob motioned and seconded by Dennis to approve the patrolman's report. Motion carried.
9. Cheryl reported receiving many safety recalls notice for the Western Star. Should someone identify that the recalls will be completed before delivered to the town after being equipped for plowing? Also received the 2027 Annual Local Road Certification of road mileage email. Clerk will forward to Rick to complete the survey by 06/22/26. Jacob motioned to approve the clerk's report. Seconded by Dennis. Motion carried.
10. Rick mentioned about road hazards and the need to quickly identify it by placing a cone to notify motorists of hazard. Afterward, as soon as possible to gravel or patch to remove the hazard. Jacob motioned to accept the chairman's report and Dennis seconded it. The motion carried.
11. Jacob motioned and seconded by Dennis to set July 6, 2026 at 6:30 p.m. for the next monthly meeting. Motion carried.
